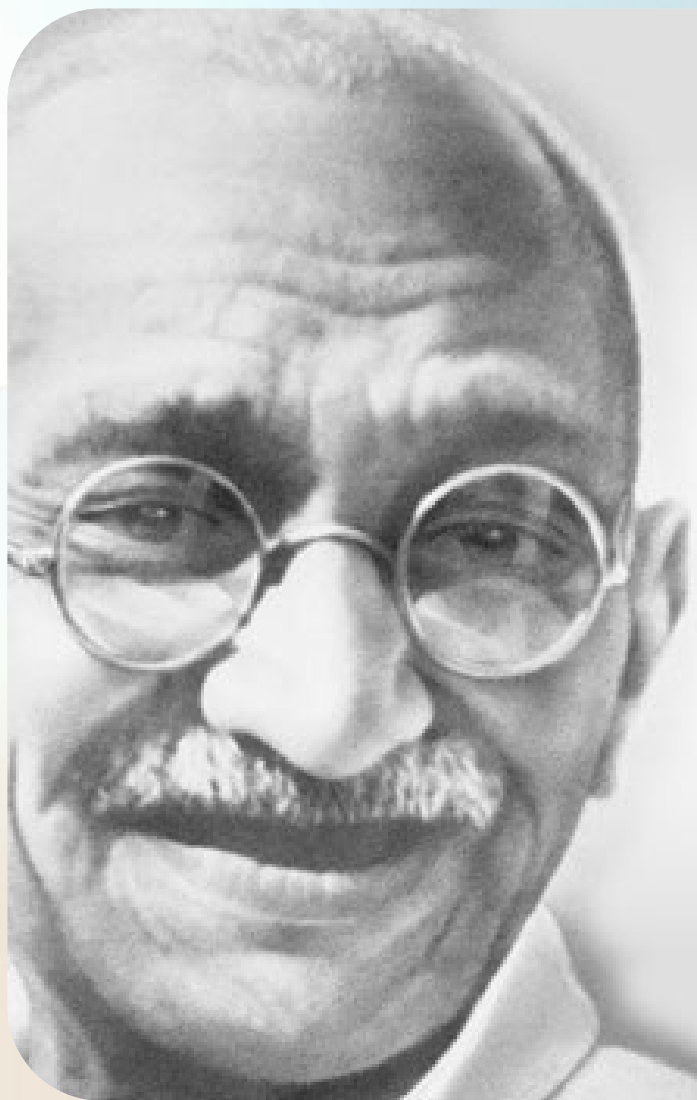

PYP Exhibition

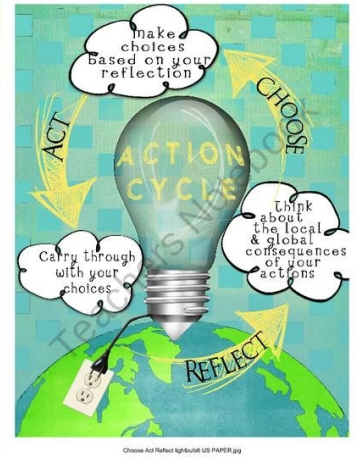


Students' choice
