CURRICULUM

Robinson School's highly competitive, rigorous, and balanced college preparatory academic program emphasizes the development of strong communication and critical, flexible thinking skills, and prompts students to connect and apply content knowledge. Beginning in the primary grades, students experience learning activities that foster problem solving and creativity, as well as leadership and character building. In addition to the English language curriculum, Spanish is a requirement at all grade levels. Middle School begins our required French Acquisition program. Strong and interconnected STEM opportunities, Design courses and Visual and Performing Arts offerings round out the Robinson program. Technology is at the forefront of student life and learning at Robinson. Classrooms and labs are state-of-the-art. Our Bring Your Own Device program begins in 4th grade, preparing students with the skills needed to succeed both now and in the future. Teachers embed the use of the Canvas LMS and Microsoft 365 tools for education into their classroom at all levels. Classes foster intellectual curiosity and promote collaborative learning. Robinson School's service learning and leadership program supports character education with a globally-minded focus. Championship teams, a diverse student population and full range of extracurricular activities help provide a well-rounded education
